



Part Four: Jesus Sends the Disciples
Matthew 28:16-20

Main Idea: Jesus has all authority to send all disciples to make new disciples of all nations.

- I. Jesus has been given all authority. (28:18)
 - A. He has the right.
 - B. He has the ability.
- II. Jesus commands all disciples to make disciples. (28:19)
 - A. The first disciples were commanded to make disciples. (19)
 - B. They are to teach those disciples to make disciples.(20)
- III. Jesus teaches how to make disciples. (19)
 - A. Going
 - B. Baptizing
 - C. Teaching
- IV. Jesus explains how long we are to make disciples. (28:20)
 - A. As long as He is with us. (20)
 - B. Until the end of the age. (20, 1 Cor 15:24)
- V. Four Directives of Jesus
 - A. We are **sent**. (John 20:21)
 - B. We are sent to **all kinds of people** (Matthew 28:19)
 - C. We are sent to all kinds of people **with a message**. (Luke 24:44)
 - D. We are sent to all kinds of people with a message **empowered by the Spirit**.
