



Part Five: We Are Sent to Live Missionally
Jeremiah 29:1-14

Main Idea: God sends us as missionaries to our location to further His Kingdom.

-Missional-

To be missional is to take on the posture of a missionary in our everyday settings and situations.

The missional vision of the church is to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to every person in the world and to make disciples of all nations—nothing less.

Each individual congregation must accept the responsibility to reach their village, community, town, or city with the good news of Jesus Christ. Every local church must operate as a missional strategy center, releasing and sending Christ followers to advance the Gospel regionally, nationally, and globally to penetrate the lostness in our world.

I. To live missionally means we will establish a presence in the city.(5-6)

- 🌐 His plan is not to rescue us from the world, but to rescue us from sin and then send us into the world.

II. To live missionally means that we will seek the peace of the city.(7)

- 🌐 His plan means we will do both good works and gospel works.

III. To live missionally means we will pray for the prosperity of the city. (7)

- 🌐 His plan is that we will seek the peace *of* the city. We are not to seek peace *in* the city. We are to be *with* the city and *for* the city, not *of* the city.
